HOW TO ADD YOUR WAREHOUSES

Note: a warehouse is a place to store equipment that is not a vehicle.

1. Log on to our website useDryLINK.com.
2. Go to the settings section in the web portal
3. Click on "Gateways & Locations"
4. Click on "Add New Warehouse"
5. Name the Facility
6. Add the address
7. Add the city
8. Add the state
9. Add the zip code
10. Scroll to the bottom and click "Save Changes"
